



**UCS Post COVID-19 In-Person Instruction Plan
2021-2022 School Year**

(Pending ALSDE Approval of ESSER III Plan)

- I. Student/Faculty/Staff Health & Safety
 - A. Sustain extra nurse hired during the 20-21 school year
 - B. Sustain hand sanitizing stations/supplies on each campus
 - C. Allow masks/facial coverings to be optional
 - D. Maintain water bottle filling stations at established water fountain locations
 - E. Utilize outdoor learning environments and seek to establish a more formal outdoor learning space
 - F. Sustain Health Science program at UCS to develop/encourage health and safety awareness
 - G. Exterior internet access points are available to encourage outdoor learning environments
- II. Continuity of Academic and Social Emotional Services
 - A. Employ 1 Full Time Mental Health Services Coordinator
 - B. Social/Emotional Learning and Character Education professional development for all faculty/staff
 - C. Social/Emotional learning and Character Education programming and counselor support for all students
 - D. Full time Guidance Counselor on staff
 - E. Employ 3 academic intervention teachers
 - F. Provide ACT preparation and skills building program
 - G. Assistive technology is available as needed for students
 - H. Implement a robust RTI and intervention program that employs STAR and DIBELS to assess students and LLI, SPIRE and IXL software for instruction and support
 - I. Additional academic intervention materials and professional development to address reading and mathematics deficiencies
 - J. Registrar/Attendance Officer to support families with school attendance and avoiding chronic absenteeism
- III. Home Screening Encouraged
 - A. Parents/Guardians should screen and monitor their children for any signs of illness including:
 1. Fever or chills; cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; fatigue; muscle or body aches;
 2. Headache; new loss of taste or smell; sore throat; congestion or runny nose; nausea or
 3. Vomiting; and diarrhea.
 4. Parents should keep their child home if he/she has any symptoms of illness.
- IV. Periodic Review and Revision of Plan
 - A. Leadership will re-visit and re-evaluate the plan during each Leadership Team Meeting
